To Planholders,

Provisions of this addendum shall become part of the Contract Documents for the above referenced project. Length of contract time and place of bid remains as specified. The date of bid has been changed to Thursday April 5 2018 at 3:00 PM.

This addendum consists of this document of 3 pages numbered Page AD1-1 through Page AD1-3.

General Items of Clarification are:

- 1. Prequalified Waste Water Treatment Plants (Section 15000). The Advantex System proposed by Advanced Pump and Equipment from Bozeman Mt. is prequalified. The Aquapoint Bioclere system proposed by Isiwest from Bozeman Mt. is prequalified. Per Article 19 of Instructions to Bidders, the owner may select either system based upon their evaluation of price proposals and submitted data for operating and maintenance costs. Capital costs, Operating and Maintenance costs, and other factors will be evaluated in awarding the contract.
- 2. **See Section 0200, Article 26**. There are no AIS requirements.

The Contract Documents are hereby amended as follows:

Contract Documents and Specifications

1. Section 00100 Invitation to Bid

Revise the first paragraph to read "Separate sealed bids.....will be received at the offices of NCI Engineering Co. at 4509 North Star Boulevard, Great Falls, Montana until 3:00 p.m. local time on Thursday April 5 2018, and then publicly opened and read aloud."

2. **Section 0200:**

- a. **Article 24.01**: Change to read: "Bidder's attention is directed to **Article 1.5.1** and **1.5.2** of **Section 0900** of these documents regarding DBE and MBE requirements."
- 3. Bidder's Checklist (prior to Section 0300): Delete column 8 of bid opening checklist. There are no Buy American requirements. Engineer will fill in column 9 as appropriate.

4. Section 00300 Bid Form

See revised bid form attached. Changes were made in quantity for bid item 304 and to ask bidders to bid both prequalified Waste Water Treatment Plants as alternate bid items 201A and 201B.

5. Section 15010 Article 3.2:

- A. **Revise section A. to read**: "Initial testing at startup, which shall include 3 days of vendor / supplier time on site, shall be conducted and paid for by the Contractor and Vendor, in the presence of the Engineer.
- B. **Revise section C to read**: "After 3 day startup is complete and after the first 30 day period of complete and satisfactory operation (by owner with vendor assistance as required) and as determined by the Engineer, treatment system shall be acceptance tested. The tests shall be conducted by the Contractor at his expense.
- C. **Section D. Revise to read** "The acceptance test shall be 60 days in duration starting at the end of the startup period, during which the vendor / contractor will be available by phone or in person *as necessary* to assist the owner in startup, sampling and testing recommendations and troubleshooting. The Owner's Certified Operator will sample effluent total nitrogen and phosphorous values and may include (as recommended by vendor) ammonia, alkalinity, pH, dissolved oxygen, at various points throughout the system as well as additional tests of BOD, and various other nitrogen tests throughout the system. **The vendor will pay for all laboratory costs associated with acceptance testing.** The need for testing will depend on the initial system performance and at the sole discretion of the Engineer in consultation with the owner and vendor. The contractor / vendor shall support the testing effort with site visits per Section 3.3B of this specification.
- D. **Revise Section E to read**: "The samples shall be collected and preserved according to the most current edition of Standard Methods for the Examination of Water and Wastewater and shall be shipped to a certified laboratory (by the responsible party) for analysis.

E. **Revise Section F to read**: "Acceptance testing shall continue until two consecutive monthly average values meet the requirements of this specification.

6. Section 15010 Article 33.3 Vendor's Services

A. Revise Section B to read: "The Vendor shall monitor and review the system data on a monthly basis during the 2-year warranty period. Based on the weekly data reviews, the Vendor shall, advise the Owner's personnel to adjust, and service the system as necessary to achieve proper operation. In the event that the Owner's certified operator makes adjustments as recommended by the vendor and the system is still out of compliance, the vendor shall visit the site and make adjustments or equipment replacements as necessary. When effluent monitoring data are collected and analyzed by the Owner, Owner will supply his data to the Vendor. The Vendor and Owner shall communicate weekly or monthly via email to coordinate all relevant activities conducted during each calendar month during this 2-year warranty period.
